May their applications be looked on favourably.	4th 17,000 of the people who were made refugees by ISIS have now returned to the Nineveh Plain. Many are Christians. Pray that they may be encouraged today.	5th Thankfully there have been limited cases of COVID-19 in the villages of the Nineveh Plain. Pray for continued protection and favour for the returning Christian population and their neighbours.
6th Pray for continued increase for our Nineveh SEED employment project. 5 projects are already providing food for their local community and much needed jobs for young people.	7th Pray for security for our team as they travel to and from projects, despite having permission. Various anti-government factions continue to use violence as a means of protest.	8th Pray for Leka, our 'sewing sister' in Jordan. May her children be greatly blessed in Jordan, and receive encouragement from being able to attend the Olive Tree Centre in Madaba.	10th Pray for the Iraqi Christian men who have created a vegetable and flower garden at the Olive Tree Centre. May they be greatly encouraged and have fresh hope for their future.	11th Please pray for the team developing content for the new website. Pray that the content will properly reflect the stories about those we are helping in Iraq and Jordan.	12th Please pray for the work being done to refresh the FRRME brand.
13th Please pray for Helena, our Jordan Country Director. Thank God for her hard work and enthusiasm.	14th Please pray for our Iraq Programme Manager, Abdulrahman.
